

ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

ENFORCEMENT:

School administration has the final word for student appearance for all school events and reserves the right to change any of the dress code at any time.

PANTS, SHORTS, AND JEANS:

Uniform pieces are expected to be worn at the waist without being oversized or too tight. Knit pants are not appropriate. Pants are to be in good condition, free from rips, holes, and tears. No blue jeans, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear

SHIRTS:

Uniform pieces are expected to be tucked in (except for K5) and fit correctly without being oversized, too tight, or worn as jackets. All shirts should have a collar. Shirts should have no emblems other than the VCS emblem or manufacturer's logo, smaller than one inch square. Shirts are to be in good condition, free from rips, holes, and tears.

SHOES AND SOCKS:

Shoes are to be closed toe, neat, and clean. Tennis shoes are to be worn on P.E. days and as part of the field trip uniform. Socks are to be worn at all times. Shoes and socks may be any style and color.

CASUAL DAY: (USUALLY ON FRIDAY AND OCCASIONALLY ON OTHER SPECIAL DAYS)

- Normal dress code shirt, Victory shirt, or solid color t-shirt
- Jeans—no holes or frays
- All modesty rules apply

BOYS

Shorts:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles, no more than 2" above the knee
- navy or khaki (stone or tan)

Pants:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles; also includes corduroy
- navy or khaki (stone or tan)

Jeans:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles
- blue wash denim

Belts:

- must be worn with belt loops
- any style and color

Oxford Cloth Button Down:

- short or long sleeved
- light blue or white
- no emblems

Polo Style Shirts:

- short or long sleeved, with collar and placket
- white, navy, or red
- no emblems unless VCS emblem

Turtlenecks and Undershirts:

- short or long sleeved (example Under Armor)
- may be worn only under a uniform shirt
- plain- solid white, navy, or black

Sweatshirts:

- worn inside or outside the building over a uniform shirt
- any VCS sweatshirt or solid navy, white, black or grey
- no emblems except for small manufacturer's logo no larger than 1" square.

Sweaters:

- worn inside or outside the building over a uniform shirt
- solid Navy, White, Red, Grey, or Black
- no emblems

Outerwear:

- coats, jackets, hats of any style and color
- only worn outside the building

Hair:

- trimmed off the ear and collar, out of eyes, and conservative style
- natural color (style or color that causes undue attention is not allowed)
- certain ethnic distinctions will be considered when in line with a student's heritage

Footwear:

- Students must wear shoes and they should be clean and neat
- No light up or roller shoes

GIRLS

Shorts:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles, no more than 4" above the knee
- navy or khaki (stone or tan)

Pants:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles; also includes corduroy
- regular or Capri length
- navy or khaki (stone or tan)

Jeans:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles
- regular or Capri length
- blue wash denim

Jumpers:

- may be worn with a white Peter Pan collared short or long sleeved shirt
- no more than 2" above the knee
- navy, khaki (tan or stone) or VCS plaid

Poly Style Dress:

- short or long sleeved with collar and placket
- no more than 4" above the knee
- navy color; no emblems

Skirts and Skorts:

- elastic waist or belt loop styles
- no more than 2" above the knee
- navy, khaki (tan or stone) or Victory plaid

Bloomers/Shorts:

- worn under jumpers or skirts
- should not be seen below the hem line

Oxford Cloth Button Down:

- short or long sleeved
- light blue or white
- no emblems

Polo Style Shirts:

- short or long sleeved, with collar and placket
- white, navy, or field trip shirt
- no emblems unless VCS emblem

Turtlenecks and Undershirts:

- short or long sleeved (example Under Armor)
- may be worn only under a uniform shirt
- plain solid navy or white

Belts:

- must be worn with belt loops
- any style and color

Leg Wear:

- tights and ankle length leggings (to be worn under a jumper or skirt)
- solid color

Accessories:

- hats, scarves, and gloves
- only worn outside the building
- any style and color

Sweatshirts:

- worn inside or outside the building over a uniform shirt
- any VCS sweatshirt or solid navy or white
- no emblems

Footwear:

- Students must wear shoes and they should be clean and neat
- No light up or roller shoes

Sweaters:

- worn inside or outside the building over a uniform shirt
- solid navy or white
- no emblems

Outerwear:

- coats, jackets, hats of any style and color
- only worn outside the building

Hair:

- neat, out of eyes, and conservative style
- natural color (style or color that causes undue attention is not allowed)
- certain ethnic distinctions will be considered when in line with a student's heritage

JUNIOR HIGH DRESS CODE

VCS student dress is expected to be modest and in keeping with Christian principles. “Modest” means that clothing is loose fitting and covers the body according to directions below. School administration has the final word for student appearance for all school events and reserves the right to change any of the dress code at any time. Violation of any portion of the dress code may result in disciplinary action, with or without warning.

YOUNG MEN

SHIRTS:

- Knit polo style shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- Button down collared dress shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must be buttoned and not worn as a jacket)
- No logo other than VCS logo or manufacturer’s logo, smaller than one-inch square

OUTERWEAR (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM TOP):

- Sweaters of any solid color
- Sweatshirt (VCS or plain, solid color)
- Outerwear does not count as a collared shirt

PANTS:

- Must be hemmed, no holes or frays; no baggy or sagging pants and must fit at the waist
- Corduroy, twill/cotton blend flat or pleated front
- Color: Khaki, Tan , Stone, Black, or Navy
- Regular or Capri length
- No blue jeans, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear
- Must have belt loops

SHORTS:

- Knee length to 2 inches above the top of knee (front and back)
- No frayed, baggy or sagging shorts and must fit at the waist
- No athletic shorts, blue denim shorts or cut offs
- Must be Khaki, Tan, Navy, or Black
- Must have Belt loops

BELTS:

HAIR:

- Off the collar and out of the eyes
- Natural color (style or color that causes undue attention is not allowed)
- Clean and neat
- No pony tails, Mohawks, or other distracting styles
- Facial hair (mustache only) must be neat and clean, no lower than corner of mouth
- No sideburns lower than the ear

OTHER:

- No head covering of any type including hats, visors and hoods indoors
- No visible tattoos or body piercing
- Clothing should not have lettering or messages

CASUAL DAY: (USUALLY ON FRIDAY AND OCCASIONALLY ON OTHER SPECIAL DAYS)

- Normal dress code shirt, Victory shirt, or solid color t-shirt
- Jeans—no holes or frays
- All modesty rules apply

PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASS:

- VCS PE t-shirt
- VCS PE shorts
- Socks and athletic shoes

YOUNG LADIES

SHIRTS:

- Knit polo style shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must have at least two buttons)
- Button down collared dress shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must be buttoned and not worn as a jacket)
- No logo other than VCS or manufacturer's logo, smaller than one-inch square

OUTERWEAR (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM TOP):

- Sweaters of any solid color
- Sweatshirt (VCS or plain, solid color)
- Outerwear does not count as a collared shirt

PANTS:

- Must be hemmed, no holes or frays; no baggy or sagging pants and must fit at the waist
- Corduroy, twill/cotton blend flat or pleated front
- No blue jeans, stretch pants, form fitting pants, yoga pants, jeggings, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear
- Regular or Capri length
- Pants must be Khaki, Tan, Stone, Black, or Navy

SHORTS:

- Knee length to 4 inches above the top of knee (front and back)
- No frayed, ripped, baggy or sagging shorts and must fit at the waist
- No athletic shorts, blue denim shorts or cut offs
- Shorts must be Khaki, Tan, Stone, Black, or Navy

SKIRTS/DRESSES:

- Knee length to 4 inches above the top of knee (front and back)
- Leggings, or tights must be worn with skirt/dress. Length requirement is still in effect
- Skirts must be a solid color or Victory Plaid

FOOTWEAR:

- Students must wear shoes and they should be clean and neat
- No Flip Flops, Athletic sliders, or Roller Shoes

HAIR:

- Natural color (style or color that causes undue attention is not allowed)
- Clean and neat

OTHER:

- No head covering of any type including hats, visors and hoods
- No visible tattoos or body piercing
- Ear piercing for ladies should be no more than two earrings per ear (no spacers)
- Clothing should not have lettering or messages

CASUAL DAY (USUALLY ON FRIDAYS AND OCCASIONALLY ON OTHER SPECIAL DAYS):

- Normal dress code
- Jeans—no holes or frays
- Modest shirts with no collars, such as t-shirts
- All modesty rules apply

PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASS:

- PE VCS t-shirt
- PE VCS shorts
- Socks and athletic shoes

HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

VCS student dress is expected to be modest and in keeping with Christian principles. “Modest” means that clothing is loose fitting and covers the body according to directions below. School administration has the final word for student appearance for all school events and reserves the right to change any of the dress code at any time. Violation of any portion of the dress code may result in disciplinary action, with or without warning.

YOUNG MEN

SHIRTS:

- Polo style shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color
- Button down collared dress shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must be buttoned and not worn as a jacket)
- No logo other than VCS logo or manufacturer’s logo, smaller than one-inch square

OUTERWEAR (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM TOP):

- Sweaters of any solid color
- Sweatshirt (VCS or plain, solid color)
- Outerwear does not count as a collared shirt

PANTS:

- Must be hemmed, no holes or frays; no baggy or sagging pants and must fit at the waist
- Corduroy, twill/cotton blend flat or pleated front
- Color: Khaki, Tan , Stone, Black, or Navy
- Regular or Capri length
- No blue jeans, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear
- Must have belt loops

YOUNG LADIES

SHIRTS:

- Polo style shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must have at least two buttons)
- Button down collared dress shirt, long or short sleeve, any solid color (shirt must be buttoned and not worn as a jacket)
- No logo other than VCS or manufacturer's logo, smaller than one-inch square
- Modesty is the intent and key factor (Guidance: shirt length should be no shorter than the top of back pocket)

OUTERWEAR (MUST BE WORN OVER A UNIFORM TOP):

- Sweaters of any solid color
- Sweatshirt (VCS or plain, solid color)
- Outerwear does not count as a collared shirt

PANTS:

- Must be hemmed, no holes or frays; no baggy or sagging pants and must fit at the waist
- Corduroy, twill/cotton blend flat or pleated front
- No blue jeans, stretch pants, form fitting pants, yoga pants, jeggings, athletic wear, sleeping pants, scrubs or similar wear
- Regular or Capri length
- Pants must be Khaki, Tan, Stone, Black, or Navy

SHORTS:

- Knee length to 4 inches above the top of knee (front and back)
- No frayed, ripped, baggy or sagging shorts and must fit at the waist

- Ear piercing for ladies should be no more than two earrings per ear (no spacers)
- Clothing should not have lettering or messages

- Normal dress code
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- Modest shirts with no collars, such as t-shirts
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
